

LA Galaxy 0 - MAN UTD 7

After the game, Galaxy coach **Bruce Arena** told reporters the game was a good lesson for his players.

"We've done this for a number of years against quality clubs," he said, "and have always been able to hang in a lot better than we did tonight, so I think it's a good lesson for our team."

Arena added that the game showed the difference between the United young players on the fringe of the first team and his youngsters.

"If they aspire to be top flight professionals" he said, "they see some of the top flight professionals and the way they conduct themselves on the field and speed of play. Our young players -- a number of our players -- still are not quality passers. And one thing you saw tonight, the passing by Manchester United was quick and crisp; it was of quality. We have too many players who are technically deficient right now, and it's something they should learn. It's also speed of thought. Quickness in moving, winning tackles, running off the ball ... all the simple things we frequently talk about but unless you see it live and in real life it's sometimes hard to have a picture of it, and they got a great picture of it tonight."
